Arrive: Monday evening, July 6th, MOC

Day 1 Tuesday Morning – An introduction, lecture format on chemical, biological, and physical contaminants, identifying macro invertebrates;

Day 1 Tuesday Afternoon – Equipment, use, and practice in the Guyandotte River

Day 2 Wednesday Stream surveys in Milam Creek from the headwaters to its confluence with the Guyandotte River. Working with a Team Leader, five teams of no more than ten persons will be given locations along the creek to practice water quality monitoring and stream assessment

Day 3 Thursday Morning and afternoon -Working as a team, data crunching, formal written assessment, interpretation, and reporting

Day 4 Friday Morning – Recognizing AMD; reflection discussions

Day 4 Friday Early Afternoon - Watershed partners will work for approximately one hour to write what they will take home from the practicum – Certificate Presentation
